creative FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Host a Game Night: invite friends, family, or neighbors over for some friendly competition. Ask for a suggested donation upon entry or charge “donation fees” to all who don’t wind up as the big winner.

Get a Local Business Involved: Many food and beverage establishments will choose specific nights to give a percent of proceeds to charity. Ask your local brewery, restaurant, or coffee shop to select Team IMPACT as their give-back recipient. Then invite your network to drink or dine

Host a Birthday Fundraiser: If you have a late summer or early fall birthday, use this special occasion as an opportunity to give back by asking for donations in lieu of gifts.

Start a Give-It-Up Challenge: Choose an item like their morning coffeehouse beverage or dinner out and ask your network to give that item up for one day, donating that amount to your fundraising page instead. By relating a donation amount to an item, it gives potential funders a tangible way to give back without giving more that they would have spent that day.

Host a Cooking Competition: Choose an dish and ask friends to cook their favorite version of that item. Everyone can taste all renditions and vote for their favorite by adding donations to that chef’s jar. The winner takes home the glory and the money gets donated to your fundraiser.

Host a Sporting Competition: Pick the sport of your choice and set up a tournament for friends and family, charging an admission fee for Team IMPACT to participate. Whether your group is highly skilled and competitive or just playing for fun, all will feel great that they’re giving back!

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
